Jesus empowers those who are His to resist the devil, and to make him flee (James 4:7 – NKJV). Nevertheless, we must continually be vigilant, for our enemy will not stop his deadly rampage until he and his minions are forever banished (Matthew 25:41 – NKJV, Matthew 25:46 – NKJV; Revelation 20:10 – NKJV).

Jesus once stated:

"Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell" (Matthew 10:28 - NKJV).

The devil is dangerous because his temptations can lead us into the path of the Creator's wrath (Romans 2:1-9 – NKJV). What God will do to those who follow Satan, is far more dreadful than any act of terrorism ever devised by mankind (cf. Revelation 19:19-20 – NKJV; Revelation 20:7-10 – NKJV; Revelation 20:15 – NKJV).
